Theme-specific networks

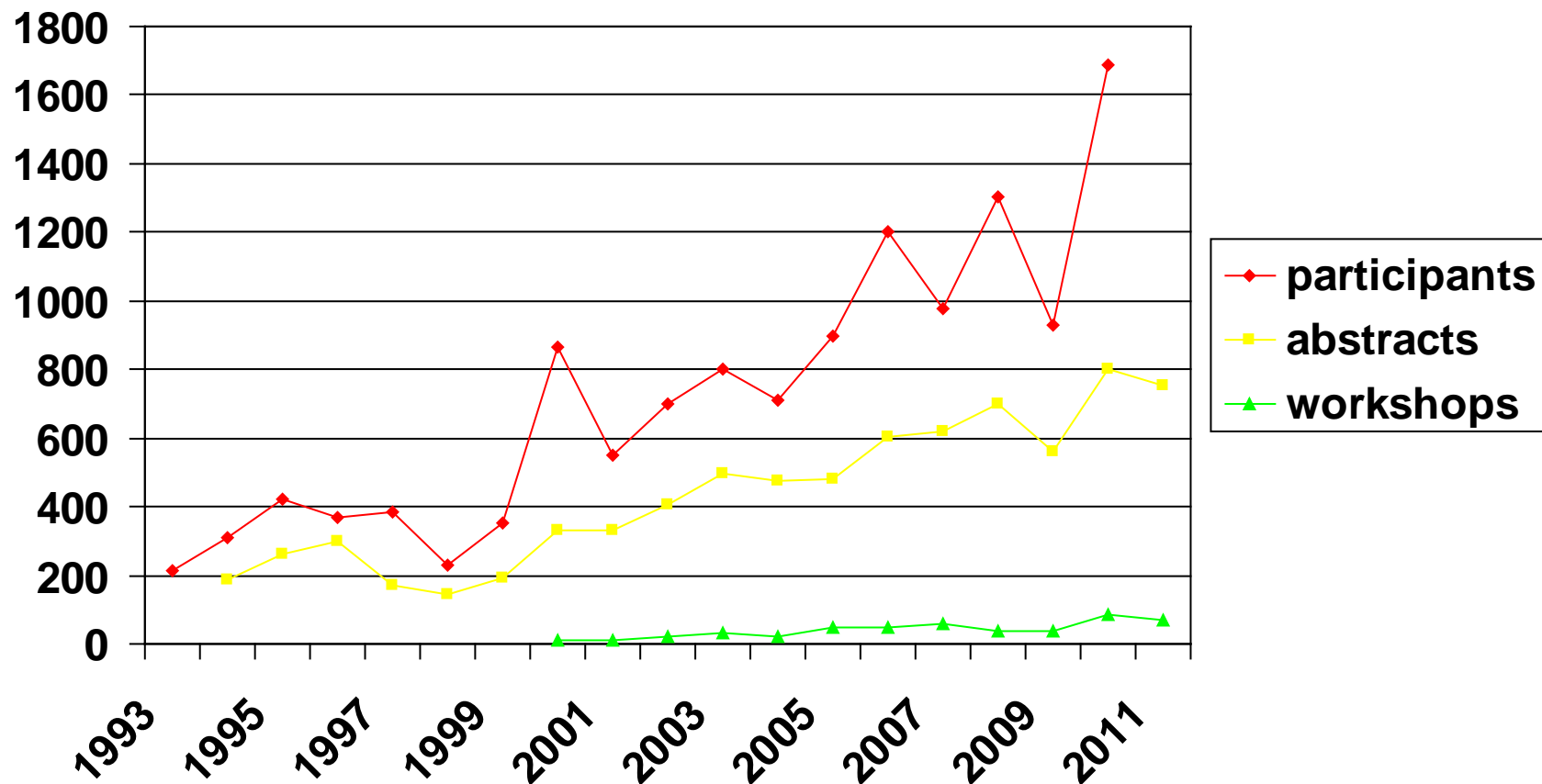


- 20 theme-specific sections

EPH conference



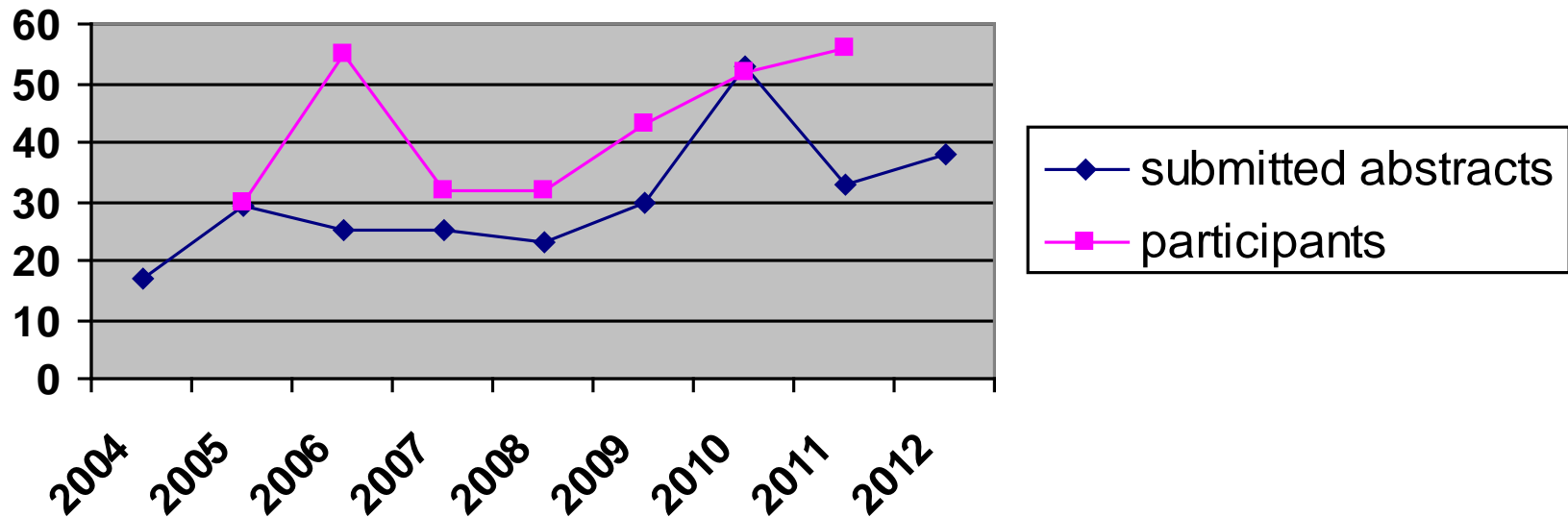
- Together with ASPHER since 2008

- For research, policy, practice and training

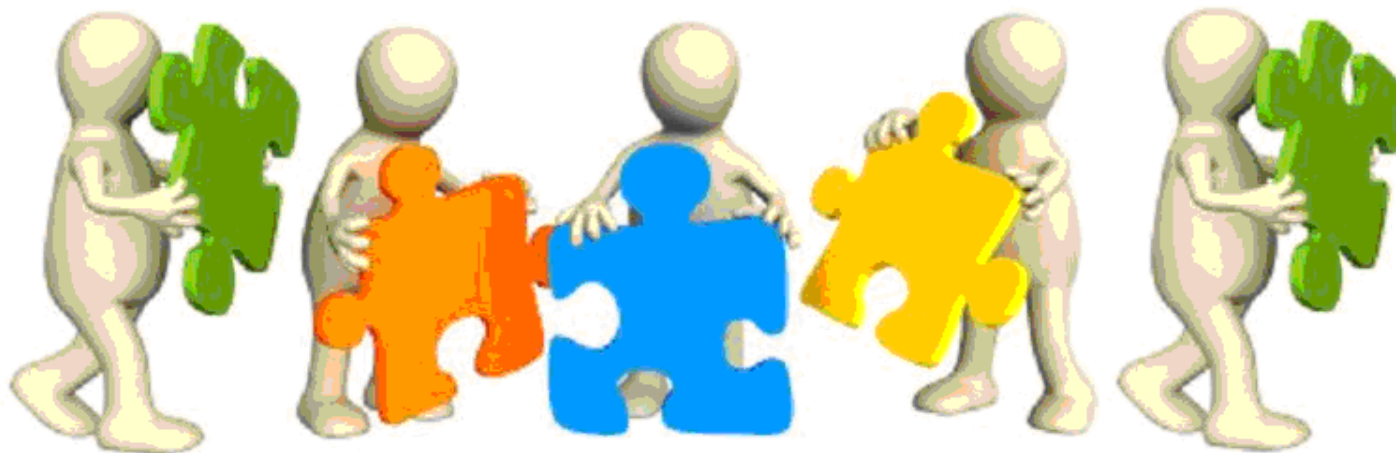
